Editorial

THE BAD SIDE OF A GOOD THING

One of the most annoying situations we encounter is that of going to the cinema only to discover that the film that was announced has not arrived on time, and another is to be shown in its stead.

We are all aware of the fact that the theater management is not at fault and are, most likely the first to become disgruntled. We also know that in the programs published by them in this publication, as well as in the Amuay Refinery's daily news sheet, "Aqui Amuay", it is clearly stated that "Management asks your forbearance if for unforeseen circumstances it may be necessary to substitute any of the films listed". But this note does not justify the inconvenience suffered almost every week by the spectators due to "unforeseen circumstances".

Of course, the case we pose, is not a matter of life and death. Quite often the substitute film is even better than the one that never found its way to Judibana.

Perhaps, in defense of theater management, we may say that they are doing everything possible to avoid further invitations to chagrin. However, it is outstandingly evident that something must be done; we don't know what, nor can we offer any suggestions. This is a problem for them to solve.

Nevertheless, we do know that this bad habit seriously injures the interest of the movie-goer and, furthermore, we strongly believe this to be the only place in the world where such a nuisance can occur so repeatedly.

THREE-TWELVE

Since October of last year, the Amuay Refinery has placed at the service of the community a new information system: Three-Twelve. By merely dialing this number -312- the most outstanding national and international news of the day can be heard.

It all started when Refinery Management decided to keep its workers continuously informed of the progress being made on Collective Contract negotiations. Hence dialing 312, everyone was kept up to date on the previous day's discussions.

The system turned out to be so satisfactory that it was then decided to amplify it to include other news of interest concerning the Refinery, the community, Venezuela, and the entire universe.

It seems that Three-Twelve has become very popular, as proven by the thousand or so calls registered daily. Three-Twelve was on night and day, relaying up to the minute news throughout the 24 hours preceding the signing of the Collective Contract and, as of today (Wednesday) it has received a total of 56,000 calls.

On the Three-Twelve staff are Juan Martínez Toro, Communications Supervisor of the Industrial Relations Group; Bill Byers, of the Telecommunications Section of the Mechanical Group, and Rafael Zabala, Bill's assistant.

Juan Martínez Toro records the news on tape. Bill Byers sits and watches him as he keeps the equipment going. The chimes between each announcement are produced by Rafael Zabala.

The system is connected to ten different outlets so that inasmuch as possible the caller does not receive a busy signal. It has become so effective that the La Salina District has begun to adopt it.

"ANNOUNCEMENT OF A FESTIVAL PIANO AND VOCAL CONCERT

THE LIBRARY COMMITTEE of the "Cecilio Acosta" High School of Punto Fijo received recently from the Creole Foundation a donation of text - books valued at Bs 2000. This donation was made upon request of the Committee and includes reference and consultation volumes to be used by the faculty and students.

A brilliant homage was paid by the Judibana Club and Creole Petroleum Corporation to the Children's Baseball Team of the State of Falcón who in recent contests have achieved national championship.

The ceremony began with a parade, after which the team's representative received a trophy from the hands of Mr. Vicente Cupello - in token of Creole's recognition of their prowess. Then Hugh Wynne, pitched the first ball in a friendly game that took place between the little champions and a team from the Instituto Educativo Judibana in which, of course, the young national heroes scored another victory.

Two thousand four hundred bolivars were received by Monsignor Francisco José Ituriza Guillén, Bishop of Coro, on the day of the twentieth anniversary of his episcopal consagration, to enable him to grant a one-year scholarship to a student of Theology.

REMINDER: Venezuelan Income Tax Declarations are to be presented to the Judibana Post Office or the Income Tax Office in Punto Fijo by the 2nd of March of 1960.

As mentioned last week, the Anti-Polio Campaign has been officially initiated with a motor car promenade through Punto Fijo, Caja de Agua, Las Piedras, Judibana and Cardón.

Last Saturday, Dr. Félix Vargas Graterol, Secretary of the State of Falcón, in absence of Dr. Pedro Luis Bracho Navarrete, who was attending the Third Convention of Governors in Caracas, laid the cornerstone of the monument to be erected in honor of the Venezuelan Federation, which is a movement headed by Juan Crisóstomo Falcón and General Ezequiel Zamora one 20th of February 101 years ago, by which Venezuela changed its status from a central republic to a federal republic. The project is being developed by the "Sociedad Amigos de Coro" and it is planned to be carried out with funds obtained through a public collection.

She has had extensive musical training and is at present the music teacher for the Colegio Americano in Caracas.

No tickets will be sold at the door the night of the concert, and no ticket will be required for admission.
